The meeting was called to order at 4:05 pm by President Capehart. The focus of this meeting is to update the committee. The committee's role is to oversee:

1. Heritage Village – Collegiate Housing Corporation
 - a. Project will begin in four to six weeks, when surveying will take place.
 - b. Governor Justice gave \$500,000 toward the construction costs
 - c. Financing is being securing – student pricing to be determined
2. Student Union need renovations to include improved accessibility.
3. Tiffany Manor is being evaluated for condition and availability, this facility would serve the upperclassman at BSC.
4. Downtown Housing would be a collaboration with the Town of Bluefield to secure 18-20 units for non-traditional students.
5. Athletic facilities will need to be renovated as funds are available.

Athletics will be seeking conferences who best serve the athletic programs.
