

Summer Financial Aid Eligibility Requirements

You must have a processed 2019-20 <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)</u> on file with the Office of Financial Aid to be considered for summer financial aid.

If you are eligible for a Federal Pell Grant during summer, we will review your eligibility. If you have been awarded your full-time initial scheduled Pell Grant during 2019-20, you must be enrolled a minimum of 6 credit hours in summer to receive an additional Pell Grant award from the 2019-20 academic year and disbursement of those funds may be delayed based on your enrollment. To receive Pell Grant from 2019-20, all outstanding requirements for that year must have been submitted to be processed by the Office of Financial Aid. Receipt of Pell Grant will be counted toward your maximum 600% lifetime Pell Grant usage limit.

You may check your Financial Aid Requirements by logging into myBSC.

You must meet all other eligibility requirements, including admission to an eligible academic program and meeting <u>Satisfactory Academic Progress</u>. You must be registered for one or more courses during the 2020 summer enrollment period for your summer financial aid request to be considered.

To complete a Summer Loan Application, you must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours. Eligibility could be limited if you requested Max Loans in the Fall/Spring semester. Click this link to continue to the loan application
