

BSC Testing Center – Student Agreement Form

- All individuals must present a photo ID to take any test/assessment at the BSC Testing Center.
- No cell phones or other electronic devices will be allowed in the Testing Center.
- Students will leave all personal belongings (including cell phones) secured in a locker prior to entering the Testing Center.
- No books, notes, or other materials will be allowed in the Testing Center (unless authorized by the instructor).
- No food, drinks, or tobacco products are allowed in the Testing Center.
- Students should arrive at the testing center early enough to allow them to finish the test within 15 minutes prior to closing.
- Students that arrive to take a test where the allotted time to complete the test may exceed the allotted time remaining before the BSC Testing Center closes must sign a <u>Testing Termination Agreement</u> <u>Form</u>.
- Students who are still testing at the time of closing will be required to submit or exit their test.
- No talking or other disturbances are allowed in the Testing Center.
- No visitors are allowed in the Testing Center (including children).
- Students may not keep or make copies of the test/assessment and may not leave the Testing Center until they are finished with the test/assessment unless closely supervised.
- If a student has purchased an e-book as the course textbook, it is the student's responsibility to bring all or part of the e-book in printed form if the exam is "open book" and said materials must adhere to the instructor's guidelines.
- Any student who feels he or she may need testing accommodations based on the impact of a disability should contact the disability services office privately to discuss specific needs. - For campus safety and integrity of the testing services, the BSC Testing Center in the Ned Shott Physical Education Building is under a 24-hour video surveillance. Additionally, all students taking a test online in the Testing Center will have their computer screen recorded during testing.
